Structured Manager Training Programmes (2024/25) (<u>Commissioned by Education Bureau</u>) Advanced Programme: For Participants who are FAMILIAR with Education and School Operation OR have completed the Foundation Programme

Programme Objective

The target participants of the Advanced Programme (AP) are serving and potential managers of IMC schools who have experience in education and school operation in Hong Kong or have completed Foundation Programme. The AP aims to help school managers effectively assume their monitoring responsibilities in Incorporated Management Committees (IMCs). The training programmes are specifically for IMCs, but some content are also suitable for School Management Committees (SMC) Chairpersons and Members of Government Schools. Enrolling in the AP is eligible to meet the Education Bureau's Soft Training Target for school supervisors and school managers.

Medium of Instruction

Cantonese will be the major medium of instruction, supplemented by English. The training materials will be in Chinese (supplemented by English, if applicable).

Programme Structure and Session Content

The AP comprises of 3 parts: Part 1 introduces school managers with the advisory and monitoring roles of IMCs in school development; Parts 2 and 3 introduce to school managers the relevant legislations in Hong Kong that affect school operations. Each part consists of two 2.5-hour sessions; a total of 6 sessions in the AP. Each session would provide two timeslots for school managers: one for weekday evenings and one for Saturday mornings. Participants are recommended to attend all 6 sessions in all parts to better prepare for their school manager roles yet can attend any sessions considering their availability.

<u>Part 1, Session 1</u> <u>Establishing an effective IMC</u>

This session is designed to provide serving and potential managers, or those with experience in education and school operation in Hong Kong, with an advanced knowledge of the functions, powers, and code of ethics of school managers in IMCs. It also focuses on the functions and roles of the Treasurer and Secretary in an IMC for the effective operations of schools. It will also discuss how IMCs can integrate the school sponsoring body's core values with school situations when developing school strategies. Through case studies, the speaker will share how to establish collaborative IMCs.

<u>Part 1, Session 2</u> Facilitating the good practice of human resources and financial management in schools - case sharing

This session is designed to help school managers with a basic knowledge of human resource and financial management in schools to develop an in-depth understanding of the rules and regulations that IMCs need to

consider when approving and monitoring the related school operations. Through case studies of selected current and important school issues related to human resources management (e.g., teacher appointment, appraisal, promotion, and complaints) and financial management (e.g., processing of tenders, use of various student learning funds, and freezing of teacher promotion posts), the speaker will lead participants to examine the factors that IMCs should deliberate for endorsing the proposals and the subsequent monitoring actions.

Part 2, Session 1

<u>Strengthening the IMCs' Understanding of the Constitutional and Legal Implications of the Law of the</u> <u>People's Republic of China on Safeguarding National Security in the Hong Kong Special Administrative</u> <u>Region (the National Security Law), the Safeguarding National Security Ordinance, the National Flag and</u> <u>National Emblem Ordinance and the National Anthem Ordinance from a constitutional and legal</u> <u>perspective</u>

This session introduces the general legal concepts underpinning the Constitution of the People's Republic of China and its establishment and enforcement in Hong Kong. It also highlights the legal concepts of the Law of the People's Republic of China on Safeguarding National Security in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (the National Security Law), the Safeguarding National Security Ordinance, the National Flag and National Emblem Ordinance and the National Anthem Ordinance. Through case sharing and discussions, the speakers help participants to understand the implications of the Ordinances for schools on the one hand and to implement feasible and effective ways of monitoring school IMCs' compliance with the laws on the other hand appropriately formulate and implement policies in safeguarding national security education.

<u>Part 2, Session 2</u> <u>Understanding school human resources management from a legal perspective</u>

This session examines two main human resource themes in schools – (1) employment and staffing issues, and (2) negligence, equality and discrimination, and protection from legal liability. The former deals with staffing matters such as selection, promotion, contract, appraisal and dismissal, and the latter deals with risk management and protection from legal liability. Using court cases reported in Hong Kong schools, the two speakers will examine the scenarios, taking into account legal constraints and school-contextual factors, and recommend possible strategies for school managers' consideration. It aims to help participants make better human resources decisions in their IMCs, and protect them from legal liability.

<u>Part 3, Session 1</u> <u>Understanding IMCs' complaint and dispute handling strategies from a legal perspective</u>

This session aims to explain to school managers the legal elements that schools must consider when dealing with complaints from the public, staff, parents, and students, and when settling disputes between different stakeholders. Through case studies, the speakers share with the participants with practical advice on how to handle complaints and disputes, with due legal consideration, to protect the IMCs from legal liability. The speakers will also introduce the Apology Ordinance to school managers and discuss its implications for schools.

Part 3, Session 2

Understanding the school risks in daily operations and student affairs from a legal perspective

This session is designed to make school managers aware of the potential risks that schools may encounter in school operations and student affairs, and the subsequent legal liabilities. It introduces school managers to the various legal concepts relating to school operations and the management of student affairs. Through the sharing of local school cases, the speakers help participants understand the legal responsibilities of IMCs in developing appropriate policies and monitoring school operations and student affairs.
