Thematic Seminars and Workshops for School Managers (2025/26) (Commissioned by Education Bureau)

For serving or potential school supervisors and school managers

Thematic Seminars and Workshops Objectives

The thematic seminars aim to introduce school supervisors and managers to significant issues affecting school operations and prepare them for effectively assuming their advisory and monitoring responsibilities in Incorporated Management Committees (IMCs). The workshops serve as a taster of mediation skills for participants to apply mediation skills in the IMCs' business. The thematic seminars and workshops are specifically for IMCs, but they are also suitable for School Management Committees (SMC) Chairpersons and Members of Government Schools. Participation in the thematic seminars and workshops qualifies members to meet the Education Bureau's Soft Training Target for school supervisors and school managers.

Medium of Instruction

Cantonese will be the major medium of instruction, supplemented by English. The training materials will be in Chinese (supplemented by English, if applicable).

Brief Descriptions of Thematic Seminars and Workshops

There are two thematic seminars and two identical mediation workshops in this school year. School supervisors and managers are welcome to register for any thematic seminar(s) and/or the workshops that suit(s) their needs and availability. The details are given below:

Thematic Seminar 1: Using Data for Continuous School Development

The speakers shall explain the importance of effectively utilising various data sources at the school level, such as Assessment Program for Affective and Social Outcomes (APASO) data and stakeholder questionnaire data. They will share practical experiences demonstrating how IMCs can leverage relevant data to guide school development and enhance school-based policies, ultimately promoting sustainable growth for the school.

Speakers: Mr NG Yau Keung Benjamin (Committee Member of the Education Commission, Committee Member of QEF Steering Committee, and Retired Principal of HKTA Ching Chung Secondary School)

Mr LUI Hang Sum Louis (Principal of PLK Centenary Li Shiu Chung Memorial College, Chairman of the Hong Kong Meta Education Management Association, Executive Committee Member of the Association of IT Leaders in Education, Microsoft Certified System Engineer (MCSE), and Microsoft Certified Database Administrator (MCDBA))

Thematic Seminar 2: Managing School Financial Resource Risks

This seminar will introduce school managers to the risks that may arise in financial management and various strategies for minimising these risks. It aims to (1) share critical and practical elements of effective financial management in schools, ensuring compliance with relevant rules and regulations from a school manager's perspective; (2) explain the legal principles underlying the verdicts of notable local court cases related to school financial management; and (3) discuss both reactive and proactive measures, using real case scenarios, that school IMCs can consider.

Speakers: Mr AU Pak Ching (Barrister-at-Law, and Retired Principal of the Society of Boys' Centres Chak Yan Centre School)

Mr NG Yau Keung Benjamin (EDB Education Commission Member, EDB Quality Education Fund Steering Committee Member, Ching Chung Koon Honorary Secretary (Education), and Retired Principal of the HKTA Ching Chung Secondary School)

Workshop on Mediation Skills - Settling Disputes with Parents and the Public (2 identical sessions)

The workshops aim to introduce mediation skills to school supervisors and managers. They are designed to inspire participants to use these skills to resolve conflicts and disputes early on, preventing escalation of issues. By applying mediation techniques, participants can enhance their communication, analytical, and problem-solving abilities. This, in turn, will strengthen the ability of IMCs to deliberate effectively and make informed decisions. The workshop

starts with an introduction to mediation fundamentals, followed by group role-playing scenarios with hypothetical cases, supervised by accredited mediators. Each workshop can accommodate up to 60 participants. If the number of applicants exceeds this capacity, spots will be allocated proportionally based on the number of applicants from each category of school managers.

Speaker and facilitators: Mr IU Ting Kwok (Solicitor, Accredited Mediator (General & Family), Accredited Family Mediation Supervisor, and Advisor to the HK Department of Justice on Mediation) and 10 accredited mediators
